**Friday 24th February, 10.15am**

**Visit to Eltham Palace**, Court Yard, Eltham, London, **SE9 5NP**

Eltham Palace is a large house at Eltham in Southeast London, England, within the Royal Borough of Greenwich. The house consists of the medieval great hall of a former royal residence, to which an Art Deco extension was added in the 1930s. It is also surrounded by beautiful gardens.

**Cost:**

Over 65s £16, Adult £17.60, Free if you are an English Heritage Member. (If you are able to book your ticket online beforehand, you can make a saving).

**Parking** is £3.00, or Free if a member. If you go there by bus it is roughly a 10-12 min walk from bus stop at Passey Place, Eltham High St.).

We will meet at the main entrance (10:15am) from Court Rd (A208), which is via the car park entrance and café area.

These graceful gardens, on the border of Sussex and Kent, are family owned and maintained – visitors often express delight at the attention to detail displayed throughout and the intimate, peaceful atmosphere.

**Cost:** £15 entry, there are no concessions for special events.
