Friday 10th July - Lavender Farm Tour

Castle Farm, Redmans Lane, Shoreham, Sevenoaks, Kent TN14 7UB

On the tour they take you into two Lavender fields and our distillery to learn about the history of the farm, the different types of lavender, how it is grown, harvested and distilled at Castle Farm. Enjoy some Lavender Shortbread and

Castle Farm Apple Juice at the end of the tour.

The tour lasts approximately 1 hour 15 minutes. The distance covered is just over half a mile on flat but sometimes uneven ground. Seating and shelter from the elements is available at stopping points in the fields and distillery.

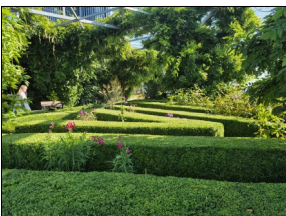
